
KENNET VALLEY HASH HOUSE HARRIERS

The Lamb Inn was converted from a farmhouse and the oldest parts of the inn are 300 years old. The bar area has memorabilia from a Wellington Bomber that crashed in the garden in 1943. It is set in the heart of the Windrush valley ,on the border of Gloucestershire and Oxfordshire and built with the famous Taynton cotswold stone (St Paul's Cathedral + Oxford colleges) and.....and.......wait a moment.....Wellington Bomber????.....crashed in the garden???.....in 1943?

Apparently so. The only survivor of the crash was the rear gunner, a Mr John Smith, who was thrown out of the tail turret upon impact landing a few feet behind the burning plane.
